1. MAPPING YOUR VISIT OF OUR WEBSITE

A. COOKIES

- i. A cookie is a small text file that is stored by the browser of your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website.
- ii. Rocateq International B.V. uses different types of cookies:
 - a. Functional cookies: These are cookies with a purely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly, so that it can, for example, remember your preferred settings. Using these, we can also optimize our website and the services through our website.
 - b. Analytic cookies by third parties: These cookies can keep track of your online behaviour. These cookies are used by Google Analytics.
 - c. Tracking cookies: These cookies are placed by an external party. By reading these cookies the advertiser recognizes you when you visit a site in which he is also involved. If you continue browsing, personalized ads can be shown. These cookies can also keep track of your online behaviour, which may result in a very specific profile being built by these parties. This profile can be so detailed that it is considered personal data.

B. CHANGE COOKIE SETTINGS

- i. Your cookie settings were set by you on your first visit to our website. All non-functional cookies can be denied per category. Placement of cookies, other than functional or anonymous analytical cookies, takes place only after an active action by you as a visitor. You can change your settings at any time via our website

C. LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING

- i. Functional cookies: The basis for processing functional cookies is the legitimate interest of Rocateq International B.V.. The interest of Rocateq International B.V. is based on the need to ensure proper functioning of the website. However, the user's interest in maintaining his or her privacy is not exceeded, as functional cookies do not collect personal data that can be used for marketing or other purposes.
- ii. Analytical and tracking cookies: The basis for processing analytical and tracking cookies concerns the consent given to Rocateq International B.V.}. This article provides that the processing of personal data is only allowed if the data subject has given his or her unambiguous consent. The requested consent gives you, the user, control over your personal data and provides transparency on how this data is used.

2. COOKIE OVERVIEW

A. COOKIE NAME, COOKIE TYPE, COOKIE FUNCTION AND THE RETENTION PERIOD

- i. The different types of cookies that the Rocateq International B.V. website uses are shown in the table below.
- ii. On rocateq.com, there are a total of 48 different cookies. The following cookies are placed on the visitor's hard drive when you visit the Rocateq International B.V. website:

These cookies are set by Google Analytics. This measures how many users visit the website, and how they use the website. Your IP address is masked, keeping you anonymous as a visitor.

Hubspot's _hstc cookie is the most important cookie for tracking visitors. It contains the domain, user tracking tokenk, the first timestamp (first visit), the last timestamp (last visit), the current timestamp (this visit) and the session number (steps for each subsequent session). This cookie keeps track of the sessions. This is used to determine whether HubSpot should increase the session number and time stamps in the _hstc cookie. When HubSpot changes the session cookie, the cookie _hssrc is set to determine whether the visitor has restarted his browser. Cookie hubspotuk is used to track a visitor's identity. This cookie is transmitted to HubSpot when submitting the form and is used to deduplicate contacts.

This cookie is set to save language settings, it also tests whether cookies are enabled.

3. GOOGLE ANALYTICS

A. GOOGLE

- i. Through our website cookies are placed by a company called Google. These cookies are part of the "Analytics" service. We use this service to investigate how you as a visitor use our website. Google makes insightful reports about this for us.
- ii. Google may provide this information to third parties if Google is legally obliged to do so, or if third parties process the information on behalf of Google. Rocateq International B.V. has no influence on this.

B. PRIVACY SETTINGS

- ii. Rocateq International B.V. has concluded a processor agreement with Google.
- iii. The information that Google collects is anonymized as much as possible. We used IP-masking, so that your location is not traceable.
- iv. We prohibited Google to use the gathered data for other products and services by Google companies (like e.g. AdWords and DoubleClick)

It is not possible for Rocateq International B.V. to guarantee that these third parties handle your personal data in a reliable and secure manner.
